SVD - Latest News

Finances: The SVD are in a fairly comfortable financial position at the moment, but our funds, mainly gained from bequests, are slowly dwindling. Donations given by clients do largely cover drivers' mileage expenses. However, other SVD costs for insurance, Duty Officer telephone costs, website hosting, Annual Party, stationery, DBS checks, etc, has led to us losing money for each of the past 5 years. There is no cause for concern, but the committee will keep an eye on the situation at regular intervals.

<u>AGM:</u> Our Annual General Meeting was held in July at the Council Offices in Staines. Among the attendees were the Deputy Mayor of Spelthorne, Cllr Mary Madams. All the members of the SVD committee were re-elected. There were no new nominations.

<u>SVD Personnel</u>: We currently have a pool of 20 drivers and 6 Duty Officers who man the phone. We are always on the lookout for more volunteers!

No. of Drives: There were 972 drives undertaken by SVD in the year leading up to April, 2018. The majority of those were to destinations within the borough, but we also ventured out to neighbouring Chertsey (St. Peters Hospital), Addlestone, Walton, Woking, Frimley, Guildford, Harefield, Carshalton and London.

<u>GDPR</u>: The General Data Protection Regulation came into effect at the end of May. SVD will not disclose client's details to any third party and will ensure personal information is held securely and protected.

<u>Ashford Clinic:</u> Podiatry/Chiropody services ceased at Ashford Clinic from 1st October. Patients now have to travel to other clinics within the borough instead. The receptionist at Ashford Clinic used to arrange transport for many clients, so those clients who require a driver to their new clinic will now have to ring SVD direct.
